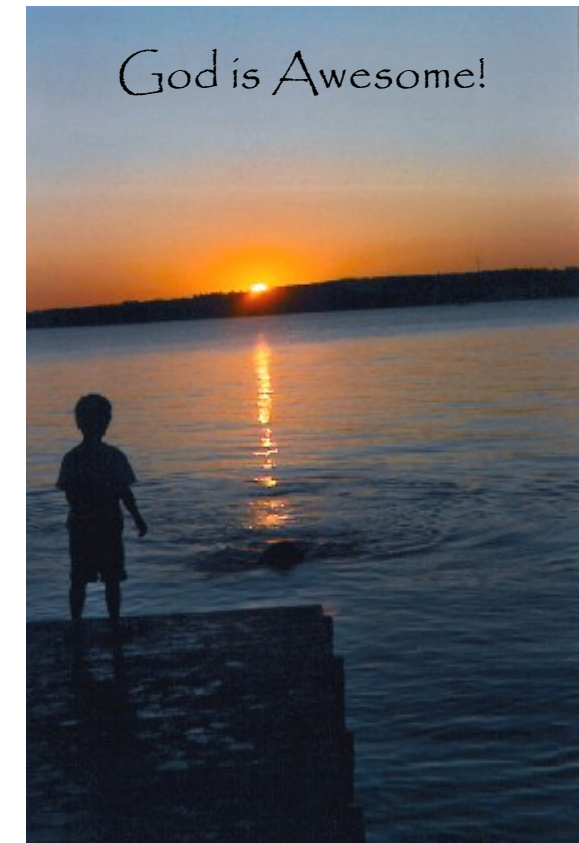


## Meet Mrs. Noack
