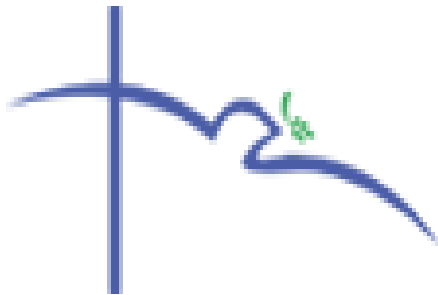


## My Philosophy of.....

**Social Studies:** American History from the Civil War to present time.

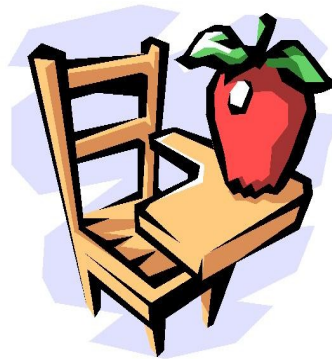
**Science:** Weather and Climate, Astronomy, and Human Biology.
