and all their nice, fat hens.

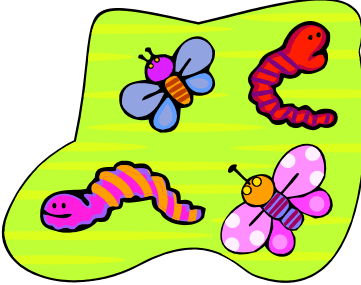
Fun Things We did
