He's living everywhere.

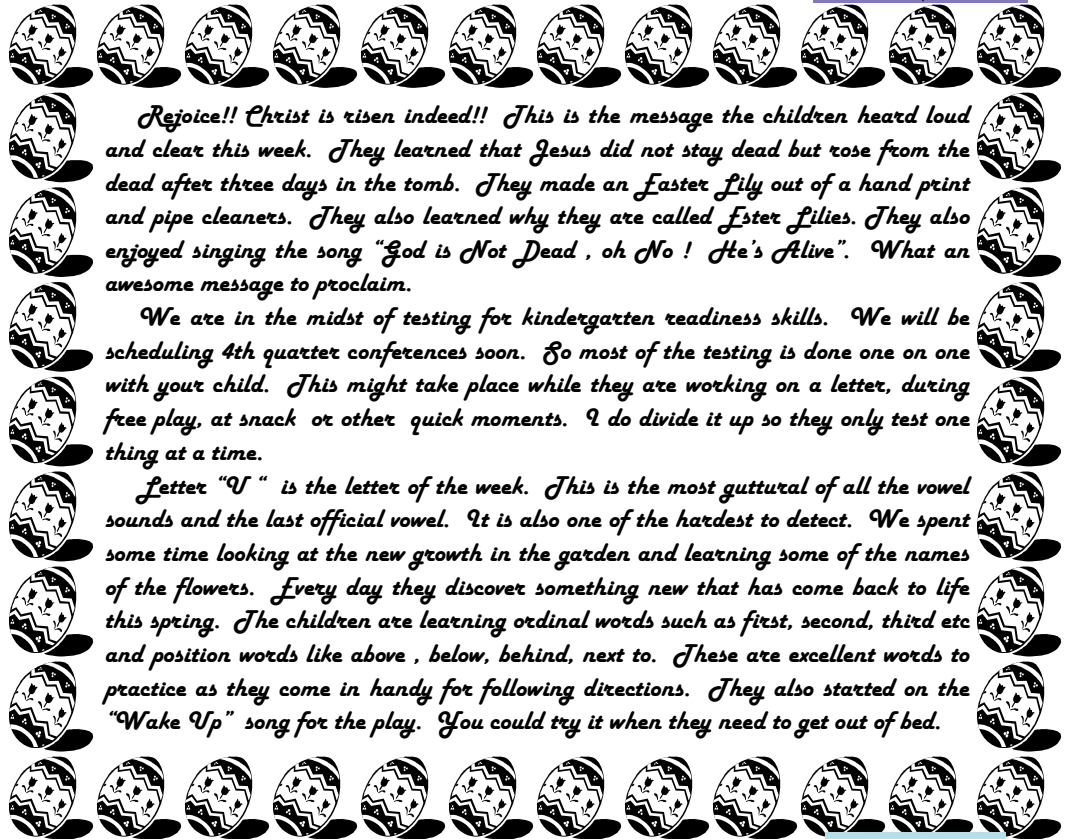
He's living in the church.
