- \* Thank the Lord for the safe return and awesome outcome after the mix-up of vehicles on Tuesday. Thanks to all who offered help.

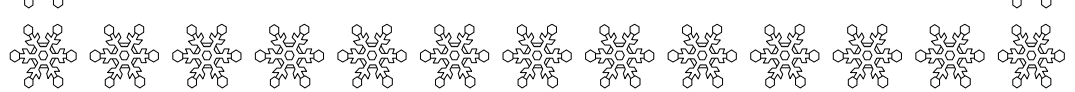
